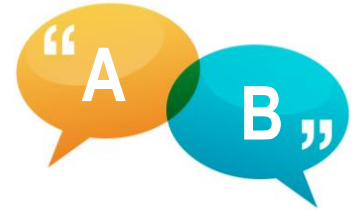

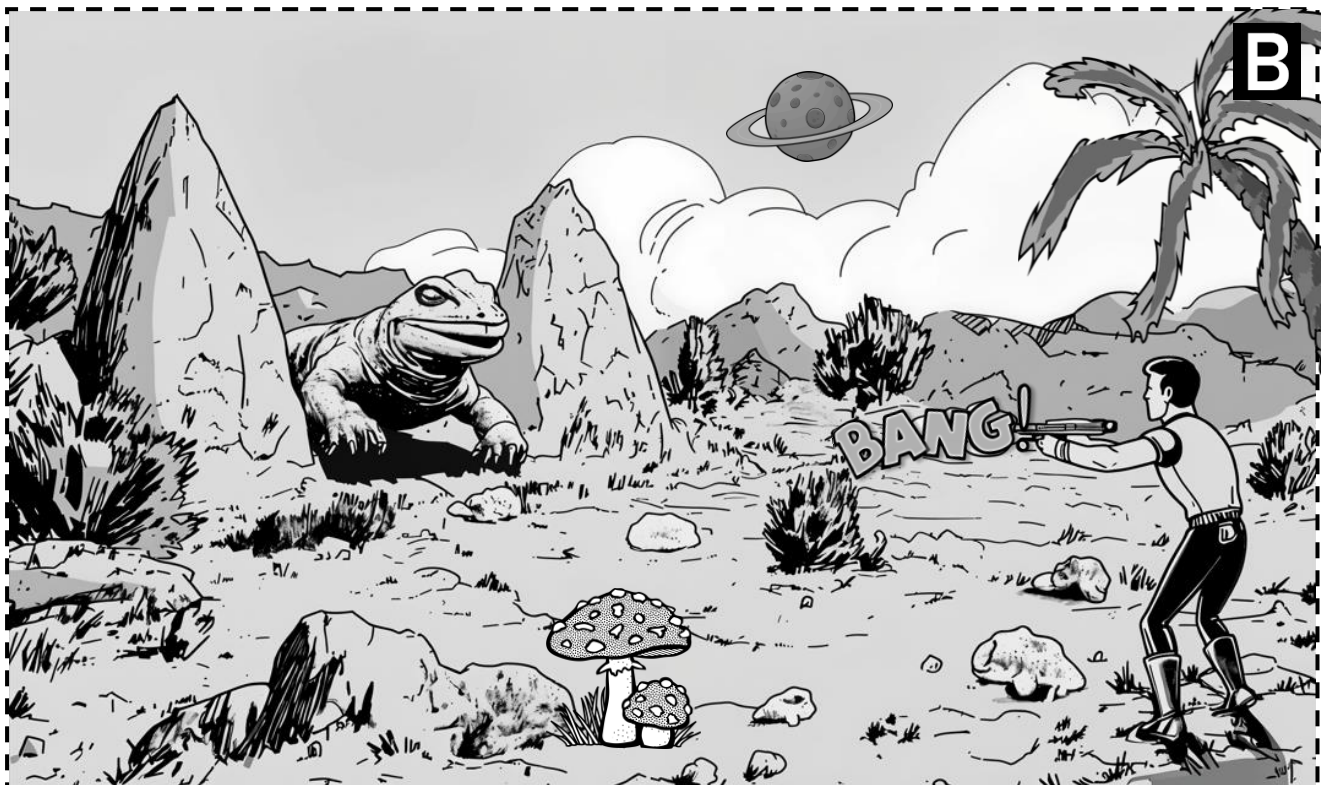
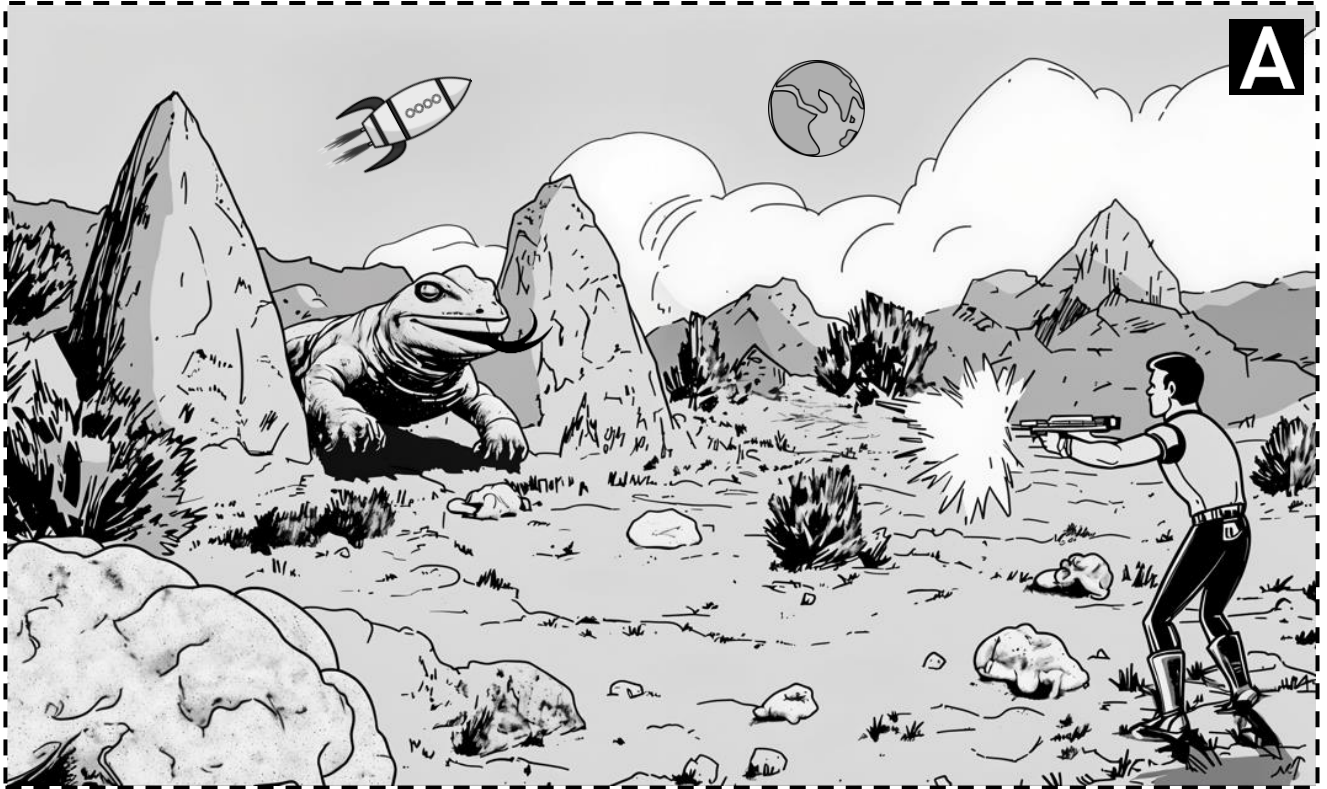

Grammar ("There is" & "There isn't" / "There are" & "There aren't")

Level Elementary to Intermediate

Time Approximately 20 minutes

ACTIVITY NOTES

Have your students sit in pairs, preferably face to face. Distribute the handouts, "A" to one student in the pair, and "B" to the other. Tell them not to look at each other's handout. Instead, they carefully describe their pictures to their partners. Tell them that there are eight differences they must find and that they have only fifteen minutes (add time if needed) to find them. After the allotted time has passed, elicit all the eight differences from your students (add five minutes).

Consider extending this activity by having your learners write a short description of one of the pictures (perhaps assigned for homework).
