ALTHOUGH

- **'Although'** is used to show a contrast. We use a subject and a verb after 'although'.

For example:

*"We liked the hotel **although** it was very expensive."*

(The fact that it was expensive is emphasized.)

*"**Although** the hotel was very expensive, we liked it."*

(The fact that we liked it is emphasized. Note the use of a comma after the introductory clause.)
